English Level 1 – <i>Learning English Basic Phonetics & Pronunciations</i>	Basic Level Learning the basics in English phonetic concepts, such as the sounds of individual letters and simple phonetic symbols. The focus is on improving pronunciation and understanding basic sounds. * Ideal for migrants who do not know how to speak, read and understand English.
English Level 2 – <i>Focus on words and forming sentences</i>	Basic Level Discover English through daily words, greetings, signs, and basic vocabulary. Building up confidence in words and speaking. * Ideal for migrants who are trying to form sentences, understand English, knows very little of reading and writing <i>English Assessment Test Required</i>
English Level 3 – <i>Focus on grammar and vocabulary</i>	Intermediate Pick up skills in grammar, vocabulary, and understanding of tenses and adjectives. * Ideal for migrants who has knowledge of English, reading, and a little bit of writing. <i>English Assessment Test Required</i>
English Level 4 - <i>Focus on communication with the right usage of vocabulary with confidence</i>	Intermediate Enhance student speaking skills and express oneself with confidence. * Ideal for migrants who want to speak confidently, improve their knowledge of English and enhance their basic writing. <i>English Assessment Test Required</i>
Conversational Mandarin Level 1	Discover Mandarin through daily conversational words, signs, and writing, and build up your confidence in speaking through songs. * Ideal for migrants who do not know how to speak Mandarin.

Conversational Mandarin Level 2	This is a continuation from daily conversational words, advanced Mandarin focuses on vocal communication and recognising Chinese characters. * Ideal for migrants who know how to converse simple basic Mandarin.

Computer Literacy Level 2 - <i>Basic Excel & PowerPoint</i>	Get an understanding of creating spreadsheets and tables as well as dynamic presentations. * Ideal for migrants who want to upskill their knowledge in Microsoft Office, Excel & PowerPoint <i>Completed Basic Computer & Word</i>
Business Marketing & Entrepreneurship	Learn how to start a business, develop a plan and how to market the products to customers. Understanding the business markets, pricing, and the location how it will impact the business. * Ideal for migrants who want to learn how to open a business and market their products in the retail or online platform. <i>Completed Microsoft Word & Excel</i>
Financial Literacy	Learn how to manage money goals, track income and cash flow and understand emergency funds. Develop and plan a 12-month money map and accountability habit. * Ideal for migrants who want to learn how to manage their money and reach their saving goals.

Basic Dressmaking	Learn how to do body measurements, simple patterns, using a sewing machine. * Ideal for migrants who do not know how to sew.
Advanced Dressmaking	Learn how to make advanced patterns on cloth and sew a blouse/dress/pants using a sewing machine. * Ideal for migrants who know how to sew a blouse and enhance their dressmaking creativity.
Basic Baking	Equip the students with basic baking skills and techniques in baking bread, biscuits, and basic cake decoration. * Ideal for migrants who do not know how to bake.
Basic Cooking	Equip the students with basic cooking skills such as steaming, boiling, pan frying, and grilling in various cuisines, such as Chinese, Japanese, Vietnamese, etc. * Ideal for migrants who do not know how to cook.
Advanced Baking	Equip the students with advanced baking skills and techniques for cake making, pastries, and cake decoration. * Ideal for migrants who have basic baking knowledge.
Advanced Cooking	Discover various cuisines from around the world: Asian, International, and Healthy Recipes. * Ideal for migrants who have basic cooking knowledge.
